






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WHO WE ARE?



We are a non-profit civil society organization that strives to provide fair and equal access to basic needs for all people, while also working to solve one of the planet's major problems - preventing waste.

Since our establishment in 2010, we have been fighting against waste and poverty, expanding our operations across Türkiye with the belief that food banking is a vital tool in combating hunger and poverty worldwide. Through the food banks we help establish, we ensure that usable food, cleaning products, and clothing rescued from waste reach families living below the poverty line. Today, through our Food Banking Network spread across Türkiye's seven regions, we continue to support people in need. As a founding member of the Disaster Platform, we also carry out humanitarian aid operations for those affected by disasters.

VALUES

Transparency

We record all our activities, as well as all donations received and distributed, and keep our stakeholders regularly informed through clear and transparent reporting.

Impartiality

In our operations, we remain neutral toward all opinions and focus on need based assistance and employment without any discrimination based on race, language, religion, gender, nationality, age, origin, marital status, disability, or sexual orientation. We conduct monitoring, evaluation, and control activities to ensure that donations reach the real beneficiaries in a fair and reliable manner.

Sustainability

We plan all our activities in a way that enables beneficiaries to achieve their own economic sustainability. We design our projects as living, evolving structures that expand their impact to wider audiences. We also ensure TİDER's economic sustainability through our social enterprise.

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT



The Basic Needs Association (TİDER) is a non-profit civil society organization that has been operating in Türkiye since 2010 to prevent waste and combat poverty. Centering its work around the food banking model, TİDER provides fair and sustainable access to basic needs for people in need, while also aiming to help individuals achieve economic independence.

The 2024 activity period was a year in which TİDER both deepened its field operations and expanded its institutional capacity. Following the devastating earthquakes of February 6, 2023, the aid operations rapidly launched in the affected regions continued this year as well. To strengthen the capacity of the Disaster Platform, of which TİDER is a founding member, the organization became one of the four partners of the *Project for Supporting the Capacity of Civil Society Organizations in Disaster and Risk Management*, implemented with the support of the European Union Delegation and coordinated by the Civil Society

Development Center. Within this scope, TİDER undertook the responsibilities of institutionalizing the Disaster Platform and establishing its legal entity.

Continuing its efforts in the regions affected by the February 6 earthquakes, TİDER launched the Adıyaman Support Market on October 29, 2023, with the support of Cargill and contributions from local partners, primarily the Adıyaman Municipality. The market has emerged as a strong social support model, meeting the basic food, cleaning, personal care, and clothing needs of 1,500 families per month. This project was awarded the Bronze Prize in the "Best Volunteer Work for a Philanthropic, Social, or Ethical Cause" category at the Corporate Engagement Awards.

In addition, through the School Nutrition Support Project, TİDER delivered a total of 53,372 hot meals to 468 students receiving bused education in Adıyaman. Within the scope of the Support Human Resources (Destek İK) project, 120 individuals were integrated into the labor market. TİDER's mission extends beyond providing aid—it aims to help people break free from the cycle of poverty.

By strengthening its technological infrastructure, TİDER prevents waste and increases efficiency through the Support Cloud (Destek Bulutu) platform, which enables location-based matching between donor institutions and food banks.

TİDER has also shared its expertise in food banking on both national and international platforms. With DenizBank as the main sponsor, it organized the 4th Food Banking Summit at Beykoz University, bringing together all stakeholders in the food banking ecosystem to foster knowledge and experience exchange. In addition, TİDER represented Türkiye at the Global Summit organized by The Global FoodBanking Network in Australia from September 9–12, 2024.

Throughout the year, TİDER strengthened social solidarity through numerous volunteer activities, collaborations, and donation campaigns, carrying out impactful projects with organizations such as Kraft Heinz, Danone, Pepsico and Kerry Foods. In addition, with the sponsorship of Cargill and in partnership with the Bursa Orhangazi Municipality, the foundation was laid for the Animal Rehabilitation Center Project aimed at supporting stray animals.

Among TİDER's goals for 2025 are further expanding its food banking network, increasing the use of technology, scaling up employment projects, and launching new social enterprises.

Standing at the intersection of social justice and sustainability, TİDER continues to touch lives across Türkiye. The 2024 report is not merely a numerical summary it is a story of hope, solidarity, and transformation.


TIDER FOOD BANKING NETWORKING

Since our establishment in 2010, we have been combating waste and poverty. With the understanding that food banking is a key tool in the global fight against hunger and poverty, we have expanded our activities across Türkiye.

Through the TİDER Food Banking Network, which spans seven regions of Türkiye, we ensure that food, cleaning products, and clothing rescued from waste reach families living at or below the poverty line.



OVERWIEW





Project for Supporting the Capacity of Civil Society Organizations in Disaster and Risk Management

It is a capacity-building program carried out with the support of the Delegation of the European Unio and coordinated by the Civil Society Development Center (STGM). Implemented in partnership with Needs Map, Support to Life Association, and Community Volunteers Foundation (TOG) all members of the Disaster Platform, of which we are a founding member the project aims to strengthen the capacity of civil society organizations in disaster preparedness and response.

Implemented in collaboration with four different stakeholders, the project involves establishing volunteer groups to ensure sound crisis management during disasters, while also providing training and practical work to ensure local communities are prepared for disasters. Awareness raising activities are underway to increase collaboration among the public, private, and civil society on disaster management. Effective information sharing and response systems are being developed in emergencies using technological tools.


Why is it important?

This project will enhance the effectiveness of civil society organizations in disaster situations, making disaster response processes more systematic and organized. It also aims to strengthen the capacity of civil society organizations in disaster preparedness and response, while ensuring that the Disaster Platform gains an official and legal identity.



Adıyaman Support Market

As of October 2023, the Adıyaman Support Market has been serving 1,500 families per month and continues to do so since its very first day of operation.



The Support Market received the Bronze Award in the "Best Volunteer Work for a Philanthropic, Social, or Ethical Cause" category at the Corporate Engagement Awards.




The School Nutrition Support Project

The School Nutrition Support Project, which was implemented during the 2023–2024 academic year and featured in our 2023 activity report, was completed at the end of the school term in June 2024.

Access to clean and nutritious food became increasingly difficult after the February 6 earthquake. We selected Adıyaman, located in the earthquake zone and where we were already active, as our project area. In collaboration with the Ministry of National Education, the first phase of support began on December 11, using the Adıyaman Teachers' Lodge Cafeteria. With TİDER's support, the nutrition program reached 13 schools and 468 students studying in combined classrooms under the transported education system. While our primary target group was primary school students, middle school students from six schools were also included, ensuring that all students in these six schools received nutritional support.

Orhangazi Animal Rehabilitation Center

With the sponsorship of Cargill and in partnership with the Bursa Orhangazi Municipality, the groundwork was laid for the TİDER Animal Rehabilitation Center. The facility, which spans 36,000 m², will provide healthcare, shelter, rehabilitation, and adoption services for stray animals. The foundation ceremony took place on November 20, and the center will operate under TİDER's coordination until May 2026, with support from Orhangazi Municipality teams.






Support Human Researcher (Support HR)

Support HR (Destek İK) is the employment project we launched in 2015 After being paused during the pandemic, we reinstated it in 2024. By the end of 2024, since its inception, the project has enabled 120 individuals to enter the labor market.

The Support Human Resources (Destek İK) project was launched to ensure the sustainability of the food banking system. Therefore, its target group consists of food bank beneficiaries. It works to help beneficiaries break free from the cycle of poverty and need and achieve economic independence. In addition, it considers donor institutions to food banks as project partners, encouraging them to employ blue-collar workers from the Support HR talent pool within their own organizations.

It serves as a bridge between food bank beneficiaries and donor institutions.



Gaziantep Inter-High School Cooking Competition

In collaboration with Stop Hunger and with the support of SODEXO, we organized the Future Chefs Cooking Competition in Gaziantep, featuring 14 female students from 7 schools. Each participant prepared two dishes a main course accompanied by either a soup, dessert, or side dish for evaluation. Vedat Topçuoğlu Vocational and Technical Anatolian High School ranked first in the Main Course category, while Şehit Karayılan Vocational and Technical Anatolian High School took first place in the Side Dish category.

The winning dishes will be included in SODEXO menus in the upcoming term. Additionally, the winning schools will receive educational materials to be used in practical lessons, and development workshops will be organized to enhance students' vocational skills and capacities.



Support Cloud

The Support Cloud Platform (Destek Bulutu) is a web based system established to match donor institutions with food banks, soup kitchens, and animal shelters that receive donations.

Food banks and donor institutions within TİDER's network create corporate accounts to access the platform. Matching between the donating institution and the organization in need is carried out directly through the system. All necessary information and documentation related to the donation process are delivered to the institutions by TİDER.

As a software that connects producers, wholesalers, and retailers making in-kind donations to the member food banks of the Türkiye Food Banking Network, Destek Bulutu enhances food banking operations, making them faster and more efficient through technology.

With its traceable and reportable system and location-based matching, the platform also reduces logistics costs, aiming to provide a nationwide solution to food waste.



4TH FOOD BANKING SUMMIT

While expanding our Food Banking Network across Türkiye with the goal of establishing a food bank in every district and operating the system with neutrality, transparency, integrity, and sustainability, we also represent our country on international platforms as a member of The Global FoodBanking Network.



To share our efforts in combating waste and poverty, introduce our human resources model that empowers individuals to become self-sufficient, raise awareness about food banking, and exchange experiences from Türkiye and around the world, we organized Türkiye's first Food Banking Summit on February 21, 2019.

4TH FOOD BANKING SUMMIT



The fourth edition of the summit was held on February 7, 2024, at Beykoz University. During the event, one panel discussed "What Can We Do to Protect Food and Prevent Waste?", while another, "Food Banking in Disasters," focused on our operations across 11 provinces affected by the Kahramanmaraş earthquake of February 6, 2023, and featured representatives from NGOs active in the field. Throughout the day, participants listened to best practices from The Global FoodBanking Network members, learned about updates to our Support Human Resources (Destek İK) project aimed at breaking the cycle of dependency, and engaged in networking and knowledge exchange during panel breaks.







Since the beginning of 2023, **Beije**, a strong supporter of the food banking system, delivered 1,500 packages of sanitary pads collected through its "Pads on the Hook" project to the Maltepe Support Market, part of our network. We extend our gratitude to everyone who contributed donations to help end period poverty in Türkiye, and to the Beije team for choosing to collaborate with us.



Within the scope of the cooperation protocol signed with **Beykoz Municipality** and **Beykoz University**, joint efforts are being pursued to reduce waste and poverty, convert food waste into animal feed, and promote clean energy initiatives.



A productive introductory meeting was held with the **Istanbul Cereals**, **Pulses**, **Oil Seeds and Products Exporters' Association (İHBİR)** to explore potential areas of collaboration and ways to create shared value.



We also participated in the second-day public sessions of the "Local Good Practices Workshop" organized on January 21–22 in Gaziantep by the **Türkiye Local NGO Humanitarian Forum (TİF)**, a network established by civil society organizations active in disaster-affected regions.



High-quality baby feeding and nursing products from **Mamajoo**, a brand under the Grup Baby companie-one of Türkiye's most established and reputable firms in the baby products sector—were delivered to beneficiary mothers through the shelves of the Maltepe Support Market.



On February 23, 2024 (Friday), our Chairwoman Hande Tibuk appeared as a guest on **Bloomberg HT's** program "30 Minutes", hosted by Hayat Ece Mağat, where she shared insights about our food banking activities and plans for 2024.



Through our partnership with The Global FoodBanking Network, of which we are Türkiye's representative, we were introduced to **Amway**, one of the world's largest direct-selling companies, via the European Food Banks Federation (FEBA). A total of 3,330 donated items, including bar soap, body soap, and toothbrushes, were distributed to beneficiaries through the İzmir–Çiğli Food Bank, a member of our network.



We also had a pleasant and productive meeting with the **AbilityPool** team, who visited our operations center in Maltepe Zümrütevler, to discuss potential collaborative projects.



As part of March 8 International Women's Day, we participated in an event held at the Community Volunteers Foundation (TOG) Support Center in Adıyaman K1 Container City, organized in cooperation with the Lider Women's Association (UNHCR), Adıyaman Municipality, and the Adıyaman Bar Association. We provided information on how to apply for support from the Adıyaman Support Market and gifted participants pouches containing personal care products to commemorate the day.



On April 28, 2024 (Sunday), we took part in the **Türkiye iş Bankası Istanbul Half Marathon.** Our volunteers ranto support our donation campaign aimed at improving the nutrition of primary school students in Adıyaman, contributing both through their participation and donations.



On May 2–3, we enjoyed watching the play "The Coal Man", prepared by **Tiyatro Tempo** and adapted from a Dutch folk tale. The performances, held in four sessions and hosted by Adıyaman Şehit Fazıl Gürs Imam Hatip Secondary School, brought together students from various schools for joyful and engaging moments.



In May, as part of the **Piggy Bank Kitchen Project** (Kumbara Mutfak Projesi), TiDER, TOKTUT, and Cargill volunteers came together for cooking events. We prepared 1,200 meals and distributed them to women, children, and youth experiencing food insecurity across five neighborhoods.



On May 31, 2024, **Adiyaman Mayor Abdurrahman Tutdere** visited the Adiyaman Support Market to receive information about the services provided.



TİDER team member Eren Can Cihan and volunteer Ali Orçun Güner participated in an earthquake drill held in İzmir, coordinated by the AKUT Foundation and hosted by the İzmir City Council, with the participation of **Disaster Platform** member organizations and local stakeholders.



Officials from the **Küçükçekmece Municipality Food Bank**, a member of the TİDER Food Banking Network, visited our operations center. We had productive discussions on strengthening collaboration and developing new projects with one of Istanbul's leading examples of food banking.



To support our Adıyaman School Nutrition Project, a **#SpreadGoodness Zumba Event** was organized on June 8 (Saturday) under the leadership of Özlem Menemencioğlu Boğahan, with the support of Instructor Gamze Yoler, who promoted the eventamong hernetwork and students. The event, hosted by Club Sporium Bostancı, drew great interest from volunteer dance enthusiasts.



Our General Manager, Nil Tibukoğlu, appeared live on June 10 (Monday) to share details about our collaboration within the "Smile With Us" project by the **Tooth-Friendly Association**, as well as to discuss our ongoing food banking activities.



On June 25 (Tuesday), Nil Tibukoğlu joined Ali Çağatay on **EKOTÜRK's Main News Bulletin**, where she spoke about food banking, the school nutrition program, and other current activities on our agenda.



The **TOKTUT** team, one of our valued civil society partners continuing to support earthquake-affected regions, visited the Adıyaman Support Market.



On August 13–14, our entire team completed a first aid training at our Maltepe Operations Center with an instructor from the **Turkish Red Crescent Tuzla Branch**. After both theoretical and practical sessions, we successfully passed the exam and received our first aid certification cards.



Our Chairwoman, Hande Tibuk, represented our association at **the Global Summit organized by The Global FoodBanking Network (GFN)**, hosted by Foodbank Australia in Sydney, between September 9–12, 2024. This year's summit focused on the link between food systems and the climate crisis, emphasizing the role of food recovery and redistribution.



On September 15 (Sunday), we took part in the Fiba Games held at Özyeğin University, where employees of all **Fiba Group** companies participated in sports competitions and social activities. At our booth, we shared information about our work and generated income by selling our products.



On October 3 (Thursday), General Manager Nil Tibukoğlu was a guest on Industry Radio's "Real Markets" program, hosted by Çetin Ünsalan, where she provided updates on our ongoing projects.



On October 4, 2024, Nil Tibukoğlu attended the Türkiye launch event of the **State of Food Security and Nutrition in the World (SOFI) Report** 2024, organized in collaboration between the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and TÜSİAD.



Our Ankara representative and sociologist, İsmail Demirci, attended the 7th **Civil Voices Festival** as an observer on October 4–5, organized by the **Civil Society Development Center (STGM)** at TED University in Ankara.



On October 14, 2024, we joined stakeholders from the agricultural ecosystem at the **3rd Positive Future in Agriculture Symposium**, hosted by PepsiCo Türkiye and the Sustainability Academy.



Our Chairwoman, Hande Tibuk, and General Manager, Nil Tibukoğlu, participated in the **Çukurova Agriculture Summit** held during the 8th International Adana Flavor Festival in Adana from October 17–20, 2024. The summit addressed key topics such as farming, production, and post-harvest food losses, focusing on the future of food.



On October 24, 2024, we attended the **3rd Food Innovation Summit,** organized by the Center for Food, Beverage, and Agricultural Policy Research (GIFT), where we listened to panels featuring prominent speakers and held discussions for potential future collaborations.



The first anniversary of the **Adiyaman Support Market**, one of the most meaningful collaborations between local government, the private sector, and civil society, was celebrated with an event attended by partner institution representatives who contributed to its success.



We participated in the **46th Türkiye İş Bankası Istanbul Marathon** on November 3, 2024 (Sunday). We thank all the runners and donors who supported us with their steps to help ensure that the Adıyaman Support Market shelves are stocked with more and diverse products.



On November 21–22, 2024, our Chairwoman, Hande Tibuk, and The Global FoodBanking Network MEA Regional Director, Gabriela A. Kafarhire, spoke at the **Sustainable Food Summit,** organized in partnership between the Türkiye Food Industry Employers' Union and the Sustainability Academy. Their session, titled "Reducing Food Losses: Cooperation and Redistribution," explored the role of food in driving change and transforming the future of food.



At our **Ordinary General Assembly** meeting on December 14 (Saturday), we reviewed our past activities and discussed new-term goals. To support our Board of Directors team, Burak Karabacak and Umut Aydın joined the board.



On December 16, 2024 (Monday), we attended the **17th "From the Heart" Awards** Ceremony organized by the Private Sector Volunteers Association (ÖSGM) at the QNB Headquarters. The event celebrated the power and impact of volunteerism, and we had the opportunity to listen to the inspiring stories behind the award-winning projects.

TİDER & TED College Acarkent Campus



A talk themed "Fighting Waste" was held at **TED College Acarkent Campus** for primary and high school students. While sharing information about our association's efforts in this area, we also discussed with the students which everyday habits we can change to help reduce waste.

Additionally, students collected food items for donation in the donation boxes we placed at the school.

TİDER & Erkan Ulu Schools Talk



We were invited to an event organized as part of the "Social Benefit Seminars" hosted by **Erkan Ulu Schools**, with participation from students of different age groups. During the seminar, we highlighted the importance of food banking in the fight against waste and poverty, as well as shared details about our other initiatives.

TİDER & Kraft-Heinz Collaboration



As part of our partnership with **Kraft Heinz**, a company specializing in the production of sauces, donation boxes were placed in their Istanbul offices to collect food donations.

Together with the collected items, various types of sauces delivered from their factories were placed on the shelves of the Şişli Food Bank during a volunteer day event.

TİDER & Işık Schools Ayazağa Campus – Talk



Within the framework of the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme, which aims to raise global citizens for a better world, **Işık Schools** Ayazağa Campus hosted a talk for primary school students focusing on the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) specifically "Zero Hunger" and "No Poverty."

Kabataş Boys High School – Community Service Practices



Students from the **Kabataş Boys High School** CIP Club volunteered at food banks as part of their Community Involvement Projects. This recurring activity, held every academic year, included the participation of 25 students.

Kadir Has University – Community Service Course



We completed the third year of our collaboration with **Kadir Has University** under its Community Service Course. This year, a total of 102 students participated, each completing 16 hours of volunteer work at the Şişli and Beyoğlu Food Banks.

TIDER & Kerry Foods - School Nutrition Support Project



Having supported our association through various projects over the years, **Kerry Foods** contributed this year to the School Nutrition Support Project implemented in Adıyaman. Within the scope of the project, the company covered the five-day meal cost for all participating children. Additionally, three Kerry Foods employees visited Adıyaman and volunteered to serve meals at one of the participating schools.

Danone Volunteer Day



Longtime supporter **Danone** organized a volunteer day event in which employees collected food donations through donation boxes placed in their Istanbul offices. Alongside the donated food items, water and dairy products produced in Danone's own factories were also delivered and placed on the shelves of the Maltepe Food Bank.

PepsiCo Volunteer Day



Our supporter **PepsiCo** provided 500 food parcels to be distributed through food banks. PepsiCo employees visited the TİDER Operations Center to help prepare all food parcels for shipment, contributing directly to the delivery process.

Analog Engineering Volunteer Day






